# Highland Park Softball Team Wins First Ever District Title; 

## AcDec Team Competes in Alaska, Places Second in the Nation

This past spring the Lady Scots softball team posted a 13-1 district record and won the first district championship in school history. The team was an Area Finalist with a 18-9 record.

The HP Academic Decathlon team won its first state title, qualifying the team to advance to the national finals in Anchorage, Alaska. With a score of 52,346.6 points, the AcDec team finished second in the nation. Leading the Scots were Michael Hodak, Raef Rothschild, Brooke Yung, Wyatt Hill, Michael Xie, Kevin Chen, Cheyenne Son, Jack Reynolds and Grant Bailey.
The girls soccer team advanced to the state finals, where it lost a 2-1 heartbreaker for the championship. Savanna Jones tied a state record with 41 career assists, ranking her 10th nationally. Over the past two years, their soccer record is 47-4-6.
The Scots baseball team rolled to a $14-0$ district record. The state-ranked team advanced three rounds to the regional quarterfinals.

The HP lacrosse team continued its strong playoff tradition by reaching the state finals. The Division I team had won seven state titles since 2004. The Division II team won the state championship in 2008, 2012 and 2015.
The tennis team, which had boasted 174 consecutive dual-match victories in a row dating back eight years, finished with a 23-1 record. In spring tennis, HP won first
and second place in every doubles event at the district meet. The Scots also finished first and third place in boys and girls singles. At regionals, Chandler Carter/ Phillip Quinn won first place, as did Brittany Newton/Logan Lett. In mixed doubles Charlie Legg/Elizabeth Thetford placed third. At the state tournament Newton/Lett placed third in girls doubles and Carter/Quinn won second in mixed doubles.
The girls basketball team, with a 10-4 district record, was a bi-district finalist.
The boys basketball team, with a 23-10 season record, was an Area finalist. Pete Davis led DFM in three-point FGs made, Stefon Jauregi was ninth in points scored and fifth in assists. Ben Reichert was fifth in rebounds.
The two girls golf teams finished as district champion and runner-up. The two teams placed 11th and 14th at regionals.
The two boys golf teams finished in first place and third place in district. The Scots were second in regionals and ninth at state. Ty Burke and Cash Carter shot 151 and finished in the top 25 at state.
The Scots football team won the district championship with a $7-0$ record, then advanced to the Area round, finishing with a 10-2 record. The district title - the Scots' 48th - set a new Texas state record. Coach Randy Allen's record at Highland Park at the end of the season stood at 194-24, including an 84-1 home record.

In cross country, the girls finished first and the boys second in district. The boys placed eighth in regionals while the girls finished sixth. Jordyn Kaplan placed 126th overall at state.

In track, the girls finished second in district while the boys came in sixth. At the Area competition, the boys finished ninth and the girls placed second. Falyn Reaugh came in fourth in state in the high jump.

Stephen Dieb again led the wrestling team and was voted District Outstanding Wrestler. He finished third in state. Regional qualifiers also included Kiefer Wetzel, Ben Kroencke, Clay McPherson, Shane Read, Caleb Kimzey, Colby Hopkins, Aidan Conner, Jeremy Hanes, Junior Dorbah and Matthew Evans.

The boys and girls gymnastics teams were both district champions. The boys finished 11th at state and the girls sixth. Adam Elahmadi and Keegan Black led he boys while the girls were led by Tatum Meeks, Lily Overton and Elli Overton.

The Scots volleyball team had another successful year, finishing as the district champions and going all the way to the fourth round of the playoffs. The Scots' record of 43-7 is the best win/loss record in school history. Falyn Reaugh and Jordan Westendorff were named to the DMN AllArea Second Team.
The Scots competed well in other nonUIL sports such as ice hockey, crew, field hockey and Ultimate Frisbee.

## RANDY ALLEN • Head Coach

This marks Coach Allen's 43rd year of coaching. He has served as a head coach for 35 years, leading his teams to the playoffs for 33 seasons. Coach Allen has the 4th most wins of any football coach in the history of Texas high school football, with a career record of 347-84-6 and a winning percentage of .810 .
A scholarship recipient in football, Coach Allen attended SMU, where he played football and baseball and graduated with a BA degree in 1972. He went on earn his Master's degree in Education from Texas A\&M.

This marks his 18th season at HP. He has the most wins of any Highland Park head football coach, with a record of 194-25. The 2005 Scots won the first state championship in 48 years with a perfect 15-0 record. In 2007 the Scots finished as State Finalist with a record of 15-1. The 2013 Scots finished as State Semi-finalists with a record of 13-2. The 2005-2006 Scots set the school record of 26 consecutive wins. The 2014-15 HP teams recorded a 20-4 record after two years in 6A. Highland Park has the most wins in the history of Texas high school football with 787 wins.
Coach Allen's teams have eight 10-0 regular season records, 14 District championships, 15 Bi-District, 8 Regional, 4 Quarterfinals, Semifinals, 2 State Finals and 1 State Championship.

Coach Allen has served on the board of directors for the THSCA from 1986 to 1989 and President in 1994-95. He was the THSCA North All Star Coach 1997. He was named Division 1-4A Coach of the Year in 2005 by the Sportswriters of Texas, Gerald Ford Texas High School Coach of the Year and also inducted into the Big Country Hall of Fame and the THSCA Hall of Honor.
In 2006 Coach Allen was awarded the Bayard H. Friedman Hero Award as Coach of the Year. In 2008 Coach Allen was the Dallas Cowboys Coach of the Week for Highland Park's 700th victory. In 2009 he was chosen for the Tom Landry Coach of the Year Award. In 2014 Coach Allen received the FCA Grant Teaff Lifetime Achievement Award as well as the FCA Tom Landry Award. In 2015 Coach Allen received the AFCA Power of Influence Award.
He wears a fedora on the sidelines when he's coaching in honor of Coach Landry. He is on leadership board advisory of the Dallas FCA. His belief in the power of faith and integrity in the lives of players and their communities led him to write two books - Coaching by The Book - the Purpose and Passion of a High School Coach (published in 2006) and Coaching Character (published in 2010).
He and his wife Carolyn have been married for 41 years Their children are Zac, wife Jennie, grandchildren Conner, Kate, Caroline and Cooper; and daughter Ashley and husband Pete Flowers have Paul, Carolyn, James and Drew.

## GRAYSON WELLS • Assistant Head Coach /

 Offensive Coordinator / Offensive LineTwenty-seven years of coaching experience, 17 with the Scots. Aside from a few years in college, Coach Wells has worked with Coach Allen for 25 years and 260 wins. Played and coached football at Tarleton State University while earning his B.S. and M.Ed. degrees. Coached in the 1993 Greenbelt Bowl All-Star Game and the 1997 Texas High School All-Star game. He and his wife Tara have been married 22 years and have three daughters: Scotlyn Grace (16) a varsity volleyball player for the Lady Scots, Kaitlyn Faith (11) a 6th grader at MIS and Evelyn Hope (5), who attends Kindergarten at Bradfield Elementary.

## Highland Park vs. Rockwall

The Scots host the Rockwall Yellowjackets tonight in the 2016 season opener for both teams.

The main storyline for Highland Park this season is its dropping back to the 5A UIL level after competing against the larger schools the past two seasons as a small 6A team. Many fans feared the 6A level would drown the Scots the past two years but the opposite happened as HP rolled to a 20-4 record, including an undefeated district title last year. The Scots more than held their own against big school competition but were tripped up by Waco Midway early in the playoffs the past two years.
Now that the Scots are back in 5A, facing familiar district opponents like West Mesquite, Poteet, Forney and others, fans are reminded that several District 15-5A teams are as challenging the 6A competition the Scots faced the past two years.
But let's focus on tonight. A good Highland Park team is hosting a solid Rockwall squad that last year won 10 games and advanced to the state quarterfinals. The Yellowjackets are favored to win their district (11-6A) and will give the Scots all they can handle this evening. The 6A versus 5A difference between the two doesn't hold much water because Rockwall has only 308 more students than Highland Park. It's not like facing Allen, with three times HP's enrollment.
The Yellowjackets bring back six starters on offense and four on defense. What they've lost is their all-district quarterback and the 11-6A Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year. But don't shed a tear for Rockwall. They simply reload each year, just like the Scots. The anchor of the offense is one of the state's top wide receivers, Sam Crawford (\#9, 6-1, 190), who last season caught 77 passes for 1,436 yards and 15 touchdowns.
Having a talented target like Crawford is one of the reasons new QB Matt Jones (\#16, 5-11, 170) should make a smooth transition from two-year backup to The Man for the Jackets. Last year he threw for 489 yards and seven touchdowns in clean-up duty.
If the Scots secondary doubles up on Crawford (which is not a bad idea), Jones has two other proven targets - Cameron Crayton (\#1, 6-2, 180) and Cole Talley ( $\# 25,5-11,180$ ) - as well as a surprise who is worth watching. Jaxon Smith (\#81, 5-10, 160) was in
eighth grade last year. To start on a major 6A team four days after freshman orientation means that this young man must have some serious athleticism.
A.J. Blacknall (\#22, 5-7, 195), who played mostly defense last season, will start at running back for Rockwall. Anchoring the line will be left guard Donik Smajli (\#51, 6-1, 285), one of the best offensive linemen in North Texas.
Defensively, the Jackets feature last year's 11-6A Newcomer of the Year, Korrey Barron (\#34, 5-10, 230), at defensive tackle. Junior

Alston Orji (\#5, 6-2, 220), who could play any position on the field, will start at weakside linebacker. His sophomore brother, Anferneer Orji (\#20, 6-1, 204), starts at safety.

The Scots are also ranked as one of the top teams in North Texas and some polls have them in the state's preseason Top 10.
Team strength begins at linebacker, where HP features captains John House (\#47, 6-0, 196) and Bennett Brock (\#96, 5-11, 215) who each had 117 tackles last season - and Matt Gahm (\#94, 6-4, 205), who had 73 tackles and four sacks in 2015. Starting at the other linebacker is senior Max Holsomback (\#42, 6-0, 204).
Turner Coxe (\#97, 6-0, 233) returns as a solid starting nose guard. He will be flanked by ends Luke Blanton (\#95, 6-1, 202) and Marshall Hammack (\#99, 6-5, 182).
The secondary is untested but deep. Starting tonight will be cornerbacks O'Neil Sitzer (\#24, 5-11, 151) and George Stewart (\#25, 5-10, 160), along with strong safety James Herring (\#30, 5-11, 170) and free safety Babe Walker (\#43, 6-2, 180).

Junior John Stephen Jones (\#9, 5-10, 169) edged out senior QBs Michael Clarke (\#12, 6-2, 185) and Jack Fain (\#6-4, 187) to earn the starting position at quarterback tonight.

The Scots are also deep at running back and wide receiver. Senior Jack Kozmetsky (\#21, 5-11, 188) will start at RB. The starting receivers will be seniors Parker Alexander (\#2, 6-0, 166), Jack Toohey (\#11, 6-0, 168) and Cade Saustad (\#88, 6-5, 188), as well as junior Scully Jenevein (\#8, 6-1, 165).
The experienced offensive line is anchored by junior tackle Thomas Shelmire (\#71, 6-3, 286), along with guard Grey Giddens (\#73, 6-1, 225), tackle Giff Giffin (\#74, 6-5, 245), guard Ben Boudreaux (52, 5-9, 218) and center JD Beverly (\#58, 6-2, 235). Your kicker tonight is Jackson Hubbard (\#33, 6-2, 170).

The Scots' 6A run wasn't the end of the world like some fans had predicted. After a couple of years in District 10-6A, the Scots rolled up a 20-4 record, including winning the district championship last season with an undefeated district record. Although HP didn't make it past the second round of the playoffs the past two years, winning 20 games in two years is impressive. Anytime. Anywhere.
Going into the 2016 season, the Scots have the most wins in the history of Texas high school football (787) ... the most 10 -win seasons (36) ... the most district championships (48) ... and the most playoff appearances (57).
It's a tradition that began more than 90 years ago and has blossomed under the leadership of Head Coach Randy Allen who, by the way, is now the fourth winningest coach in Texas high school football history.
So with the Scots now back in 5A, the biggest difference in football will be in the playoffs. But other sports at HP will compete
better with schools that are closer to the same size. (Although Allen is triple the size of Highland Park, the Scots beat them in basketball.) The 5A competition should be just about as strong as 6A but the playoff runs should be a little longer.
The Highland Park coaches will tell you that it doesn't matter to them who the Scots play. They'll line up against anyone in 5A or 6A or the Big 12. While HP is not known for the quantity of Division I college players, the quality is there, starting with 1948 Heisman Trophy winner Doak Walker, who legendary sportswriter Blackie Sherrod said was the best running back he had ever seen play football.
Recent NFL players from HP include Matthew Stafford (Detroit Lions), Daniel Sepulveda (Pittsburgh Steelers), Kyle Williams (Seattle Seahawks), Dave Richards (San Diego Chargers) and Anthony Schlegel (New York Jets). But the most amazing story is how quarterback Bobby Layne and running back Doak Walker led the Scots to the state semifinals in the ' 40 s, then reunited in the same backfield a decade later to lead the Detroit Lions to the NFL championship.
Doak's son, Russ, started on the Scots' 1977 state quarterfinalist team, and now Russ has a son who is playing on the Highland Park freshman team. So the grandson of the greatest football player in Highland Park history is carrying on a family tradition. Oldtimers will get misty-eyed at hearing the freshman's name. Why?

Because Doak Walker is back at Highland Park.

Now in his 18th year overseeing the Scots offensive line, assistant head coach and offensive coordinator Grayson Wells has seen it all.
"I like to see guys step up when we lose a player to injury," said Wells, "They work harder and rise to the occasion. It impresses me how they can step up and get the job done."
Senior Harrison Murski (\#54, 6-1, 215), was second team all district last season as a guard. When healthy, he is one of the top linemen in the district. He is smart, quick, tough, and is a great leader. His father, Mike, was a star Scots lineman back in his day, but more importantly, he owns a ranch near Meridian where the offensive line holds it retreats while hunting and fishing. The tallest O-lineman is senior Giff Giffin (\#74, 6-5, 245), the starting right tackle who was a starter much of his junior year. He's got a big body and has offers from MIT and Georgetown. He is also the deep snapper and is a captain of the Scots track team.
Junior Thomas Shelmire (\#71, 6-3, 286) was first team all-district as a sophomore. The starter at left tackle has an offer from SMU. He's big, physical , aggressive and has quick feet. He's got an easy-going personality but doesn't play that way. Shelmire is one of he hardest workers on the team.
Senior Grey Giddens (\#73. 6-1, 225) is a returning veteran who can play any position on the O-line. He's smart, quick and knows he offense well. He is committed and has taken on more of a leadership role as injuries strike. He played quarterback in 7th grade and in he could do it again if called upon.
