

Remember, Everyday is a Great Day to be a Scot and Scot Fight Never Dies!



## Highland Park Softball Team Wins First Ever District Title; AcDec Team Competes in Alaska, Places Second in the Nation

This past spring the Lady Scots softball team posted a 13-1 district record and won the first district championship in school history. The team was an Area Finalist with a 18-9 record.

The HP Academic Decathlon team won its first state title, qualifying the team to advance to the national finals in Anchorage, Alaska. With a score of 52,346.6 points, the AcDec team finished second in the nation. Leading the Scots were Michael Hodak, Raef Rothschild, Brooke Yung, Wyatt Hill, Michael Xie, Kevin Chen, Cheyenne Son, Jack Reynolds and Grant Bailey.

The girls soccer team advanced to the state finals, where it lost a 2-1 heartbreaker for the championship. Savanna Jones tied a state record with 41 career assists, ranking her 10th nationally. Over the past two years, their soccer record is 47-4-6.

The Scots baseball team rolled to a 14-0 district record. The state-ranked team advanced three rounds to the regional quarterfinals.

The HP lacrosse team continued its strong playoff tradition by reaching the state finals. The Division I team had won seven state titles since 2004. The Division II team won the state championship in 2008, 2012 and 2015.

The tennis team, which had boasted 174 consecutive dual-match victories in a row dating back eight years, finished with a 23-1 record. In spring tennis, HP won first

and second place in every doubles event at the district meet. The Scots also finished first and third place in boys and girls singles. At regionals, Chandler Carter/ Phillip Quinn won first place, as did Brittany Newton/Logan Lett. In mixed doubles Charlie Legg/Elizabeth Thetford placed third. At the state tournament Newton/Lett placed third in girls doubles and Carter/Quinn won second in mixed doubles.

The girls basketball team, with a 10-4 district record, was a bi-district finalist.

The boys basketball team, with a 23-10 season record, was an Area finalist. Pete Davis led DFM in three-point FGs made, Stefon Jauregi was ninth in points scored and fifth in assists. Ben Reichert was fifth in rebounds.

The two girls golf teams finished as district champion and runner-up. The two teams placed 11th and 14th at regionals.

The two boys golf teams finished in first place and third place in district. The Scots were second in regionals and ninth at state. Ty Burke and Cash Carter shot 151 and finished in the top 25 at state.

The Scots football team won the district championship with a 7-0 record, then advanced to the Area round, finishing with a 10-2 record. The district title – the Scots' 48th – set a new Texas state record. Coach Randy Allen's record at Highland Park at the end of the season stood at 194-24, including an 84-1 home record. In cross country, the girls finished first and the boys second in district. The boys placed eighth in regionals while the girls finished sixth. Jordyn Kaplan placed 126th overall at state.

In track, the girls finished second in district while the boys came in sixth. At the Area competition, the boys finished ninth and the girls placed second. Falyn Reaugh came in fourth in state in the high jump.

Stephen Dieb again led the wrestling team and was voted District Outstanding Wrestler. He finished third in state. Regional qualifiers also included Kiefer Wetzel, Ben Kroencke, Clay McPherson, Shane Read, Caleb Kimzey, Colby Hopkins, Aidan Conner, Jeremy Hanes, Junior Dorbah and Matthew Evans.

The boys and girls gymnastics teams were both district champions. The boys finished 11th at state and the girls sixth. Adam Elahmadi and Keegan Black led he boys while the girls were led by Tatum Meeks, Lily Overton and Elli Overton.

The Scots volleyball team had another successful year, finishing as the district champions and going all the way to the fourth round of the playoffs. The Scots' record of 43-7 is the best win/loss record in school history. Falyn Reaugh and Jordan Westendorff were named to the DMN All-Area Second Team.

The Scots competed well in other non-UIL sports such as ice hockey, crew, field hockey and Ultimate Frisbee.

## VARSITY COACHING STAFF



#### **RANDY ALLEN • Head Coach**

This marks Coach Allen's 43rd year of coaching. He has served as a head coach for 35 years, leading his teams to the playoffs for 33 seasons. Coach Allen has the 4th most wins of any football coach in the history of Texas high school football, with a career record of 347-84-6 and a winning percentage of .810.

A scholarship recipient in football. Coach Allen attended SMU, where he played football and baseball and graduated with a BA degree in 1972. He went on earn his Master's degree in Education from Texas A&M.

This marks his 18th season at HP. He has the most wins of any Highland Park head football coach, with a record of 194-25. The 2005 Scots won the first state championship in 48 years with a perfect 15-0 record. In 2007 the Scots finished as State Finalist with a record of 15-1. The 2013 Scots finished as State Semi-finalists with a record of 13-2. The 2005-2006 Scots set the school record of 26 consecutive wins. The 2014-15 HP teams recorded a 20-4 record after two years in 6A. Highland Park has the most wins in the history of Texas high school football with 787 wins.

Coach Allen's teams have eight 10-0 regular season records, 14 District championships, 15 Bi-District, 8 Regional, 4 Quarterfinals, Semifinals, 2 State Finals and 1 State Championship.

Coach Allen has served on the board of directors for the THSCA from 1986 to 1989 and President in 1994-95. He was the THSCA North All Star Coach 1997. He was named Division 1-4A Coach of the Year in 2005 by the Sportswriters of Texas. Gerald Ford Texas High School Coach of the Year and also inducted into the Big Country Hall of Fame and the THSCA Hall of Honor.

In 2006 Coach Allen was awarded the Bayard H. Friedman Hero Award as Coach of the Year. In 2008 Coach Allen was the Dallas Cowboys Coach of the Week for Highland Park's 700th victory. In 2009 he was chosen for the Tom Landry Coach of the Year Award. In 2014 Coach Allen received the FCA Grant Teaff Lifetime Achievement Award as well as the FCA Tom Landry Award. In 2015 Coach Allen received the AFCA Power of Influence Award.

He wears a fedora on the sidelines when he's coaching in honor of Coach Landry. He is on leadership board advisory of the Dallas FCA. His belief in the power of faith and integrity in the lives of players and their communities led him to write two books – *Coaching by The Book - the Purpose and Passion of a High School Coach* (published in 2006) and Coaching Character (published in 2010).

He and his wife Carolyn have been married for 41 years. Their children are Zac, wife Jennie, grandchildren Conner, Kate, Caroline and Cooper; and daughter Ashley and husband Pete Flowers have Paul, Carolyn, James and Drew.

#### **GRAYSON WELLS** • Assistant Head Coach / **Offensive Coordinator / Offensive Line**

Twenty-seven years of coaching experience, 17 with the Scots. Aside from a few years in college, Coach Wells has worked with Coach Allen for 25 years and 260 wins. # **BEFORE THE KICKOFF**

#### Highland Park vs. Denton Ryan

HP football players have dreamed of challenging the top-ranked 5A football team in the state and today that dream comes true.

The Scots face number-one-ranked Denton Ryan in the 5A Division I state semifinals at AT&T Stadium. The Ryan Raiders were the pre-season pick to win the state championship by *Texas Football* magazine, and the Scots were predicted to face them in this semifinals match.

Like the Scots, the Raiders have played the previous two seasons on the 6A level. With the opening of the new Braswell High School in Denton, enough Ryan students were transferred to move Ryan back to 5A. Last season Ryan went 13-1, losing to Allen in the state quarterfinals. This year the Raiders return 15 starters and have run up a 14-0 record. Counting HP, Ryan has faced 12 teams that have qualified for the playoffs.

"If you want to win a championship, you have to play Denton Ryan at some point,"

said HP head coach **Randy Allen**. "They are 27-1 over the past two years. The team is seasoned, talented and confident. They are very fast, strong and very well coached."

Last weekend the Scots had their hands full against a good Mansfield Legacy team, led by lightning-quick quarterback **Kendall Catalon** and 2,000-yard running back **Kameron Session**. The Broncos had averaged 44 points per game going into the Highland Park game and something unsettling happened to them against the Scots. Their high-octane offense was shut down.

The Broncos ran the ball 31 times and gained only 103 yards. They threw the ball 29 times and completed 16 for 134 yards. They punted seven times and picked up 14 first downs. Legacy didn't score until halfway through the final period but were knocking at the door with 49 seconds left when Scots cornerback **George Stewart** came up with the big play (see inside back cover) to end Legacy's comeback and its season.

Catalon proved to be magically evasive. He was very hard to catch and bring down but never did break for a long run. As it turns out, the best way for the Scots to prepare for elusive Denton Ryan quarterback **Spencer Sanders** was to try to corral Catalon, which they did. Catalon and Sanders are very similar in style.

The problem is that Sanders is a little quicker, a little faster and

leads a better team that has won 27 out of its last 28 games.

The Raiders beat Colleyville Heritage, 24-10, last Saturday at AT&T Stadium. Ryan's strategy was to eat up the clock and keep the high-flying Panthers offense off the field. It worked. Heritage ran only 45 offensive plays while Ryan ran 78. The Raiders outgained the Panthers, 456 yards to 245 yards. The Ryan defense held Heritage to 10 points, well below its average of 44.

The key to the Raiders offense is the quarterback Sanders, a junior. This season he has completed 220 of 348 passes for 3,232

yards and 38 touchdowns. And he is shifty and can run like lightning. This season he has carried the ball 184 times for 1,087 yards and 18 more touchdowns.

Running back **Tyreke Davis** has run 153 times for 1,026 yards and 10 TDs. In his spare time he is Ryan's all-state linebacker. Sanders' top two receiving targets are **Gabriel Douglas** (1,219 yards) and **Chritauskie Dove** (1,151 yards) who have scored 33 times between the them.

"Ryan's defensive front is strong and fast," said Allen. "The defensive ends,

Kaelin Murray and Thomas Wilson, and tackles Earnest Brown and Dayton LeBlanc are exceptional."

The Denton Ryan coach, **Dave Henigan**, got his high school coaching start at Highland Park, where Coach Allen hired him as quarterbacks coach and freshman team coach. When he left HP he became the offensive coordinator at Ryan for two years when the team played in back-to-back state championship games. The next 10 years he was head coach at Corsicana and Grapevine. He is now in his third year as Ryan's head coach.

"I've known Dave for a few years now and I don't think there's a finer guy," said Allen. "We enjoyed him and his family. I remember having lunch with him at Chip's on Lovers Lane and asking him to come join us at Highland Park."

Ryan began the season with a Murderer's Row of non-district games that included Lancaster, Poteet, Wylie East and Frisco Lone Star. The Raiders soundly defeated each one.

With the Scots winning Region II, Division I and the Poteet Pirates winning Region II, Division II, a statement has been made about how tough and deep district 15-5A is. It would be hard to argue that there's a better district in North Texas this year.

Today's bottom line is that if the Scots contain QB Sanders like they did QB Catalon, they have a good chance to advance.



# THE YEAR IN REVIEW



#### Highland Park 43, Rockwall 21 (August 26 at Highlander Stadium)

In John Stephen Jones' first 10 minutes as the Scots quarterback, he threw three touchdown passes – two to Paxton Alexander and one to Scully Jenevein – giving the Scots a 22-0 lead at the end of the first quarter. The Yellowjackets came back with two second quarter scores but Jones hit Cade Saustad with a short TD pass as the half ended. HP led 29-14 at that point. In the third quarter Jones connected with Hudson Wood on a 25-yard touchdown pass (Jones' fifth of the game) and then an alert JD Beverly fell on a fumble in the end zone to score. At the end of three periods, the Scots led, 43-14, and ultimately won the game, 43-21.

#### Waxahachie 40, Highland Park 37 (September 2 at Lumpkins Stadium in Waxahachie)

In a high-scoring game that went back and forth, the Indians scored on a six-yard pass with 19 seconds left to win, 40-37. Waxahachie quarterback Bryce Salik threw for 320 yards and four touchdowns. Star wide receiver Jalen Reagor caught eight passes for 205 yards and three TDs. Sprinter Kenedy Snell scored on a 90-yard pass and a 48-yard run. The Scots held the Indians to 11 first downs but the Indians gained 454 yards, mostly on big plays. Although Waxachachie was ranked in the state's Top 10, it did not make the playoffs from district 10-5A. Ironically, this season HP beat three of the Mansfield teams that did make the playoffs.

#### Highland Park 31, Mansfield Timberview 0 (September 9 at Highlander Stadium)

The defense pitched its first shutout as the Scots won their second home game. QB Jones hit Jenevein with a short TD pass in the first quarter, then Jones had touchdown runs of 24 yards and 20 yards in the second half. A 27-yard field goal by Jackson Hubbard and a five-yard TD run by Paxton Alexander completed the Scots' scoring. But the HP defense was the story of this game. It held the Wolves to 83 yards passing and 34 yards rushing for the game – 117 yards of total offense. They held the Wolves to nine first downs and forced three fumbles.

#### Highland Park 27, Lovejoy 20 (September 16 at Highlander Stadium)

In a close Homecoming game for the Scots, Lovejoy was leading, 20-14, in the second quarter when Jones threw a 13-yard TD strike to Jenevein to put the Scots up, 21-20, at halftime. Lovejoy receiver Chase Van Wagoner caught an 85-yard TD pass and a 73-yard TD pass from QB Carson Collins in the first half but Jack Kozmetsky countered those with two of his own and finished the night with over 100 yards rushing. Saustad emerged as a go-to receiver with six catches for 87 yards. Jones had another good night, connecting on 22 of 34 passes for 265 yards. The Scots defense held the potent Leopard offense to 44 yards on the ground and only 10 first downs, plus they forced four turnovers – three interceptions and a fumble. Matt Gahm's pick six iced the game for the Scots.

# THE YEAR IN REVIEW



#### Highland Park 66, North Forney 7 (September 23 at City Bank Stadium in Forney)

The Scots overwhelmed the Falcons by jumping out to a 39-7 halftime lead. Jacob Urbanczyk led the Scots with 92 yards and three touchdowns. The leading receiver for HP was J.T. Dooley, who caught four passes for 70 yards. Jones completed 14 of 21 passes for 205 yards and two touchdowns (to Wood and Ryan Waters). Gahm scored again on a blocked punt in the end zone and Michael Clarke scored from five yards out in the second half. The HP defense held the Falcons to 82 yards rushing, 93 yards passing and nine first downs. The Scots offense racked up 535 yards in total offense and 23 first downs. Many HP backups saw action in this game.

#### Highland Park 25, West Mesquite 3 (October 7 at Mesquite Memorial Stadium)

In a hard-fought game the Scots scored once in each quarter and held a good Wrangler offense to just a field goal. West Mesquite would ultimately make the playoffs and then shock the world by knocking undefeated and state-ranked Texarkana Texas High out of the playoffs in the first round. But the Scots methodically battered the Wranglers as Kozmetsky scored twice in the first half and Jones scored twice in the second half. Urbanczyk was the leading receiver, coming out of the backfield for 52 yards. The Scots defense held the Wranglers to 124 yards in the air, 109 on the ground, 11 first downs and no TDs. The Scots intercepted two Wrangler passes.

#### Highland Park 40, Poteet 29 (October 14 at Highlander Stadium)

HP used a 24-point third quarter to distance itself from the Poteet Pirates in the battle between the top two teams in the district. The Pirates had struck first, with a shocking 90-yard fumble return for a touchdown by Cha Cha Corbin. But the shock wore off quickly as 14 seconds later Jones hit Wood with a 75-yard TD pass to tie the score. A couple of Pirate drives ended in short TD runs by Daiquain Jackson to give Poteet a 22-7 lead early in the second quarter. A 43-yard TD strike from Jones to Saustad and a Hubbard field goal tightened the score to 22-16 at the half. Jones had a monster game, completing 18 of 33 passes for 426 yards and three TDs. Kozmetsky gained 145 yards and scored two touchdowns. Wood had 138 yards in receptions, Saustad had 127 and Dooley had 75. The Scots have advanced to the state semifinals in Div. I while Poteet has advanced to the state semifinals in Div. II.

#### Highland Park 44, Forney 7 (October 21 at City Bank Stadium in Forney)

The Fighting Jackrabbits struck first on an 8-yard TD pass to take a 7-0 lead in the first quarter but it was all HP after that as the Scots reeled off 44 unanswered points. Jones tossed TD passes to Saustad and Dooley, and on the ground Urbanczyk and Kozmetsky scored in the second quarter to give HP a 27-7 halftime lead. Urbanczyk and Paxton Alexander each scored again in the second half then Matteo Cordray added a 26-yard field goal to complete the scoring. The Scots defense held Forney to nine first downs, 125 yards passing and 78 yards rushing. Plus the HP secondary intercepted three Jackrabbit passes. It was the Scots' sixth straight win.

#### Highland Park 49, Royse City 3 (October 28 at Highlander Stadium)

The Scots scored on all five of their first half possessions to roll up a 35-0 halftime lead as they clinched a share of the 15-5A title. The HP defense held its third opponent to three or fewer points. Royse City was held to 74 yards passing and 102 yards passing. Jones was six for six passing for 104 yards and two TDs. QBs Clarke and Jack Fain each saw action. Clarke completed eight of nine passes for 80 yards and two touchdowns. Fain ran three times for 36 yards and a TD. Kozmetsky scored twice. Ten Scots caught passes – Jack Toohey, Parker and Paxton Alexander, Wood, Saustad, Dooley, Jenevein, Brennan Fewin, Jon Welfelt and Davis Willoughby.

#### Wylie East 20, Highland Park 9 (November 4 at Wylie Stadium)

Wylie East made a major statement by outplaying the Scots in the final district game. Both teams had qualified for the playoffs and winning or losing didn't change their first round games. The Scots held Raider standout runner Eno Benjamin to 186 yards (below his average) and were subpar on offense, defense and special teams. HP had hoped for a fourth-quarter rally but Wylie East fed the ball to Benjamin 15 times on its final drive, a 17-play, 69-yard drive that iced the game. The Scots managed only three field goals and had two punts blocked. It was the first time since the season opener in 2013 that the Scots failed to score at least one touchdown.

#### Highland Park 70, Mount Pleasant 2 (November 12 at the Ford Center at The Star in Frisco)

The defense held Mount Pleasant to 65 yards of total offense and two first downs while the offense scored 70 points. Six HP ball carriers scored – Jones, Kozmetsky, Urbancyzk, Fain, Clarke and Cameron Reeves. Toohey, Saustad and Kozmetsky caught TD passes. Everyone on the bench got to play in this game as the Scots rolled up 516 yards of total offense to win the bi-district match.





# THE YEAR IN REVIEW



#### Highland Park 45, Frisco Independence 3 (November 18 at the Ford Center at The Star in Frisco)

Facing the top 5A offensive machine in North Texas, the Scots defense made a huge statement. Independence was the only team averaging more than 500 yards per game and HP held it to 148 total yards, 12 first downs and most importantly, only three points. Dom Williams, who had gained more than 2,000 this season, was held to 36 yards on 14 carries. HP's two leading receivers, Saustad and Jenevein, were both injured and lost for the season. Dooley stepped in and had a breakout game, catching six passes for 97 yards and two touchdowns. More people began to take notice of the Scots and their iron curtain defense.

#### Highland Park 41, Mansfield Lake Ridge 27 (November 25 at the Ford Center at The Star in Frisco)

Last year Lake Ridge had come out of nowhere and advanced to the state finals. Although star quarterback Jett Duffey graduated and headed to Texas Tech, the Eagles were still powerful this year. They had scored 87 points against Samuel the weekend before. They averaged 42.5 points per game and watched as HP put on an offensive show early. On the Scots' first play from scrimmage, Jack Kozmetsky flew 48 yards for a touchdown, then added another five minutes later. HP led 21-0 at the half and 28-0 in the third quarter. Kozmetsky was lost for the season with a broken arm but Paxton Alexander took his place and scored three touchdowns.

#### Highland Park 14, Mansfield Legacy 7 (December 2 at the Ford Center at AT&T Stadium in Frisco)

After a defensive standoff – seven punts and one interception on the game's first eight drives – Jones found Parker Alexander in the back of the end zone for a 15-yard touchdown. In the third quarter, Parker's younger brother, Paxton, took a Jones screen pass on a third-and-goal from the 25 and, following some good blocking, danced down the sideline for a touchdown. A solid Legacy of-fense finally scored in the fourth quarter to make it 14-7, then later drove to the HP seven-yard-line and faced a fourth down in the final minute. A fade pass into the end zone to tie the score was swatted away by HP's George Stewart and the Scots prevailed.
