

Highland Park Win UIL Lone Star Cup for Record 11th Time; Four Scots Teams Win 2018-19 State Championships

Highland Park won the 2019 5A UIL Lone Star Cup, marking the 11th time the Scots have won the award – more than any school in UIL history. This season Highland Park won state championships in team tennis, football, boys golf and girls soccer.

The Scots also won bronze medals in academics, boys wrestling and boys swimming & diving.

It was the third year in a row that the HP football, tennis and boys golf teams won state championships. The girls soccer team won its seventh state title, the most soccer championships of any school (boys or girls) in the state.

The Lone Star Cup recognizes the top six Texas high schools in each of its six enrollment classifications based on their overall team achievement in a variety of sanctioned academic, athletic and music championships. The statewide competition began 22 years ago during the 1997-98 school year.

The Scots finished with 124 points, which tied them with Argyle for the most points in all categories statewide. Last year the Scots were the runners-up in the Lone Star Cup with 83 points. This year HP totalled 41 more points to give them a total of 124 points. Three schools from the Dallas-Fort Worth area finished in the 5A top ten – Lovejoy, Aledo and

Sports and competitions included in the scoring are volleyball, marching band, tennis, team tennis, cross country, football, swimming, wrestling, basketball, soccer, golf, track & field, academics, oneact play, softball and baseball.

Highland Park won the Lone Star Cup in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2017. The Scots finished in third place in 2009, fifth place in 2010 and second in 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2018. The Scots' 11 wins are the most for any school on any level.

After the Highlander Band finished 10th in the state band competition last year (the band's highest finish in school history), the band's Wind Symphony placed second in state this year. "Winning two Lone Star Cups over the past three years demonstrates the breadth of our students' abilities, and their dedication to doing their best in a wide array of athletic and academic endeavors," HPHS Principal Walter Kelly said. "Beyond this dedication, they have done so through a commitment to Highland Park High School and have done so sideby-side with their friends and teammates. I am so proud of our students and their success."

"What an outstanding job by our students and staff - in addition to earning the 11th overall title, it is the 15th time in the 22-year history of the Cup that the Scots have finished first or second," HPISD athletic director Johnny Ringo said. "We scored 124 points, the most in school history, which is a true reflection of HPISD's excellence in all areas."

"Winning the Lone Star Cup is quite an achievement and is symbolic of excellence in the important areas of academics, arts and athletics," HPISD Superintendent Dr. Tom Trigg said. "Congratulations to everyone who contributed to this monumental accomplishment: students, teachers, directors, coaches and the many parents who support them."

RANDY ALLEN • Head Coach

2019 marks Coach Randy Allen's 46th year of coaching. He has served as a head coach for 38 years, leading his teams to the playoffs for 37 seasons. Coach Allen has the fourth most wins of any football coach in the history of Texas high school football, with a career record of 392-87-6 and a winning percentage of .820.

and a winning percentage of .820. A scholarship recipient in football, Coach Allen attended SMU, where he played football and baseball and graduated with a BA degree in 1972. He went on to earn his Master's degree in Education from Texas A&M.

This marks Coach Allen's 21st season at Highland Park, where he has a record of 239 wins and 28 losses. With 832 wins, the HP football program has the most wins in the history of Texas high school football. Under Coach Allen, HP's home record is 101-1. The 2005 Scots won the first State Championship in 48 years with a record of 15-0. The 2016 team (14-2), the 2017 team (15-1) and the 2018 team (16-0) each won state championships. HP is only the 18th team in the history of Texas high school football to win three consecutive state titles. Sportswriters have called HP's 2017 dramatic come-from-behind win against Marvel, 53-49, the greatest State Championship game in UIL history.

Coach Allen served on the Board of Directors of the THSCA from 1986-89 and was President of the THSCA in 1994-95. He was Coach of the North All-Star Team in 1997. He was named Division 1-4A Coach of the Year for 2005 by the Sports Writers of Texas, Gerald Ford Texas High School Coach of the Year, and also inducted into the Big Country Athletic Hall of Fame and the THSCA Hall of Honor.

In 2006 he was awarded the Bayard H. Friedman Hero Award as Coach of the Year. In 2008 he was the Dallas Cowboys Coach of the Week for HP's 700th victory. He was the 2009 Tom Landry Coach of the Year. In 2014 he received the FCA Grant Teaff Lifetime Achievement Award and the FCA Tom Landry Coach of the Year award. In 2016 he was selected for the AFCA Power of Influence Award.

Coach Allen was the 2018 DMN All-Area Coach of the Year, District 15-5A Coach of the Year, the Don Shula National High School Coach of the Year for the NFL in 2017 and the NFHS National Coach of the Year in 2018.

He is also a 2017 SMU Distinguished Alumni recipient.

Coach Allen's belief in the power of faith and integrity in the lives of players and their communities led him to write "Coaching by The Book – The Purpose and Passion of a High School Coach", published in 2006 and "Coaching Character" published in 2010.

Highland Park vs. Mansfield Legacy

The Scots welcome the Mansfield Legacy Broncos to Highlander Stadium tonight for Highland Park's 2019 Homecoming game.

The two programs have fought several good battles over the past few years, highlighted by the 2016 state quarterfinals when HP edged Legacy, 14-7, as the Broncos were throwing into the

end zone to tie or win the game on the final play. As many remember, Scots defensive back **George Stewart** swatted the potential touchdown pass away from the receiver's hands as time expired. Highland Park went on to win the state championship.

"Legacy has a history of great teams," said HP head coach **Randy** Allen. "They have the athletes and the coaching. They had three D-1 players last year. They have playoff experience and pride in what they do. Their quarterback has been hurt and he may be back for our game. They will be coming off an open date so they'll be prepared for us."

The Broncos come into the game 0-5, and yet are still predicted to qualify the playoffs. In district play they have lost games to state-ranked Lancaster, 61-0, and crosstown rival Mansfield Timberview, 19-2. The Broncos dropped their pre-district games to Jenks, Oklahoma (38-0), Crowley (52-14) and 6A Mansfield (37-7). After tonight their next four games will be against Bryan Adams, Samuell, Sunset and Woodrow Wilson.

The Broncos are led by running back **Ayo Adeyi** (#21, 5-7, 173) who has run for 442 yards and scored three touchdowns. Quarterback **Dante Chaney** (#5, 5-10, 187) has thrown for 163 yards while the other QB, **Andrew Smith** (#7, 5-10, 160) has thrown for 111 yards and a touchdown. The Scots may see both tonight. Legacy's top two receivers are **Richard Rocquemore** (#12, 5-10. 170) and Adeyi, coming out of the backfield.

Legacy is averaging 4.6 points per game while its opponents are averaging 41.4. The Broncos have scored three touchdowns this season, all three by Adeyi – two on the ground and one in the air.

The Scots continue to improve. After the loss to Frisco Lone Star (who replaced the Scots as the state's top-ranked 5A team) HP has won two games by the average score of 64-0.

After winning the first two games of the season to Rockwall, 66-59, and Mesquite Horn, 52-25, the Scots were stopped by Lone Star, 30-19. As district play started HP won its first two games to Bryan Adams, 62-0, and Woodrow Wilson, 66-0.

Highland Park came into the season as the pre-season pick to win the state championship, something that did not happen the previous three years as the Scots won three titles in a row. But the

> loss to Lone Star gave HP a clear indication what, how and where the team needed to improve. That message should help the Scots in the heat of the playoffs.

HP's dual-threat quarterback **Chandler Morris** (#4, 6-0, 178) continues to lead the team in passing and rushing. He has passed for 1,604 yards and 17 touchdowns while rushing for 264 yards and nine more TDs. **Doak Walker** (#22, 5-9, 170) has gained 172 yards on the ground and 51 by air, scoring three touchdowns. First-team running back **Hunter Heath**

(#38, 5-6, 145) is back from an injury and picked up 114 yards against Woodrow Wilson. Junior running back **Brooks Bond** (#31, 5-11, 165) leads HP rushers with four touchdowns. Injured RB **Will Anderson** (#2, 5-9, 180) is expected to be ready soon.

HP's top WR is **Ben Smith** (#3, 5-8, 150) with 619 yards and six TDs, followed by **Paxton Anderson** (#6, 6-4, 200) with 307 yards and three TDs, **Case Savage** (#4, 5-10, 170) with 304 yards and four TDs and **Will Pettijohn** (#86, 5-10, 170) with 161 yards.

The Scots defense has thrown two shutouts in a row through district play. They continue to get better and will continue to be tested as the schedule gets tougher. Special teams have done well while waiting for injured kicker **Wesley Winters** (#94, 5-11, 170) to get better. **Hayden Clyce** (#11, 5-11, 172) has filled in nicely and has proven to be the most vicious tackler of all area kickers.

Homecoming will feature football captains from years ending in nine, including 1999, Coach Allen's first HP team. A 1969 captain, **Paul Flowers**, will be surrounded by some of his grandchildren, whose other grandfather, Coach Allen, will be also be honored at halftime for recently becoming the third winningest coach in the history of Texas high school football.
